

Minutes for Town of Wilson Monthly Meeting 1/13/2026

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dan Meyer at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Dan Meyer, Supervisors Ed Shilts and Aaron Vizer, Clerk Danielle Barka and Treasurer Robin Richardson. Also present was Tom Richardson.

On motion by Vizer/Shilts the Board approved the minutes of the December meeting as printed.

The Treasurer's report was presented to the Board. Tax collections will commence on January 31st.

In road and park related items; the Town truck had a rear end issue and was taken in to be repaired. The approximate cost to fix will be between \$6,500 and \$7,000. The Town was able to borrow the Town of Ludington's truck until the truck is repaired. Ron will go around and sand the iciest of the roads.

The next Wisconsin Towns Association meeting is on January 29th at 7:00pm in the Town of Clear Creek if any Board members would like to attend.

Xcel Energy will be adding an antenna to their existing tower on County Road G and wanted to verify no permits through the Town were needed. The Open Book will be held on Thursday, April 2, 2026 from 3:30pm to 5:30pm at the Town Hall. The Board of Review will be held on Thursday, April 30th, 2026 from 3:30pm to 5:30pm at the Town Hall. As a reminder any property holder must attend the Open Book prior to attending the Board of Review.

The Clerk submitted the new 2026 mileage rate of 72.5 cents/mile per the State of Wisconsin. Per Vizer/Meyer the Board approved the new rate.

In public comment Aaron Vizer on behalf of Jolene Huth inquired as to whether a conditional use permit was required by the Town for a non-profit youth horse program. The Board confirmed the Town does not require one.

The Clerk submitted bills for payment; all of which were approved along with any others that arrive and are due before the next monthly meeting.
