

Minutes for Town of Wilson Monthly Meeting 2/11/2025

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Meyer at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall. Present were Chairman Meyer, Supervisors Ed Shilts and Aaron Vizer, Clerk Danielle Barka and Treasurer Robin Richardson. Also present were Tom Richardson, Wayne Bonick, and Jesse and Ashley Wampole.

On motion by Shilts/Vizer the Board approved the minutes of the January meeting as printed.

The Treasurer's report was presented to the Board. Of note, the February tax settlements for the school districts and County totaling \$267,540.27 were sent.

In road related items; Lonny Roth finished all of the roadside brush cutting. Jesse and Ashley Wampole were concerned that the brush was cut too far into their property; Meyer noted that it should not have been cut any further in than 33 feet from the center of the road which is the Town right of way. Total for brush cutting should total around \$9,600. Meyer presented the pavement ratings for the roads and bridges. He also noted that the bridge project on Gravel Pit Road is still set to begin in 2026 and the Town is still responsible for approximately \$8,000 for engineering costs. Finally Meyer noted that the exhaust for the hall furnace seems to be building up with ice and has asked that it be checked on frequently until Comfort Heating and Cooling is able to come and correct the problem. It was also noted that the float stick on the LP tank seems to be sticking and to keep a close eye on LP levels with the upcoming extreme cold. River Country Co-op did recommend straightening the tank up come spring.

Meyer provided the Board with the Eau Claire County/Town Emergency Operations Plan and asked that it be looked over when everyone has time.

The Clerk submitted bills for payment; all of which were approved along with any others that arrive and are due before the next monthly meeting.

The next regular Board meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, March 11th, 2025. Shilts/Vizer moved to adjourn that meeting at 8:04 pm.
