

Minutes for Town of Wilson Monthly Meeting 7/7/2026

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dan Meyer at 7:05 pm at the Town Hall. Present was Chairman Dan Meyer, Supervisors Ed Shilts and Aaron Vizer, Clerk Danielle Barka and Treasurer Robin Richardson. Also present were Tom Richardson and Wayne Bonick

On motion by Vizer/Shilts the Board approved the minutes of the June meeting as printed.

The Treasurer's report was presented to the Board. The Board moved to transfer the Bridge fund to a 9 month CD at a 4% rate. The Town also received 2% fire dues which will be paid to Boyd-Edson-Delmar fire department.

In road and park related items; the new bridge on Gravel Pit Road is now open to traffic. Augusta Griffith was concerned there were homeless camping at the park as well as vandalizing doors. She said she cleaned the doors and the people are no longer at the park. Dave Acker noted the light was out at the park; Ed will take care of fixing or replacing it. Haas will haul blue granite this week and the culverts were replaced on Hay Creek Road and Stoney Lonesome Road. Hank Huth dug the culverts and replaced them and Tim Pilgram hauled the material away. On motion by Vizer/Shilts the Board moved to pay Hank \$800 for 5-6 hours of work. Tim Pilgram will be paid between \$400 and \$500. It was also discussed that dust control will no longer be permitted to be applied by private residents due to over application. The Town looked into chip seal via Jack Dittmar of Scott Construction and 20ft wide by 1/2" thick with hot oil mix would be approximately \$50,000 per mile however this is not in the Town budget. Finally Ron will get new reflective tape for the bridge.

The Clerk submitted bills for payment; all of which were approved along with any others that arrive and are due before the next monthly meeting.

The next monthly meeting was scheduled for ~~Tuesday, August 4th, 2026~~. **THURSDAY August, 6th, 2026.**

On motion by Vizer/Shilts the meeting adjourned at 7:47pm.
