

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FIRE PROTECTION CHARGES

WHEREAS, 1983 Wisconsin Act 532 authorizes Towns to charge property owners a portion or all of the costs of fire protection;

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the Town of Wilson to charge the costs of such protection to property to owners;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Wilson does ordain as follows:

Section 1 - State Authority

Pursuant to Section 60.55, 60.555, and 60.557 of Wisconsin Statutes the Town of Wilson, Eau Claire County, hereby establishes the following policy and procedure for the payment of fire costs incurred by the Town of Wilson.

Section 2 - Liability for Fire Protection Costs

The property owners of real estate within the Town of Wilson for which fire protection is provided shall be responsible for the costs of the fire calls made to their property by either the Stanley Fire Department, the Boyd Edson Delmar Fire Department or any other fire department utilized.

Section 3 - Billing and Payment Procedure

The costs of fire calls shall be billed by the Town Clerk to the property owner and paid to the Town Treasurer within 90 days of the date of the bill. Those bills remaining outstanding for more than 90 days as of November 1 of any year shall become a lien against the real estate from which fire protection was provided and shall be placed on the tax roll as a delinquent special charge pursuant to Section 66.60 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4 - Separability of Provisions

Should any section or provisions of this ordinance be declared invalid, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5 - Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of September, 1988.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular Town Board meeting of the Town of Wilson on July 11, 1988.
