

## TOWN OF WILSON

### ORDINANCE #2-2012

#### Section I: Purpose.

This Ordinance allows for the issuance of an operator's (bartender's) license for service or sale of alcoholic beverages in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 125. All licensees shall be familiar with and comply with Wisconsin Statute 125 and this Ordinance.

#### Section II: Eligibility.

The applicant must be at least 18 years of age and have completed an application form supplied by the town clerk in order for the board to consider approval. The application must be signed and notarized. All arrests and convictions of the applicant shall be disclosed on the application or on an attached sheet. The applicant for the license must present, with the application, proof that the applicant has successfully completed a responsible beverage server training course under Section 125.17 of Wisconsin Statutes and a fee of \$20.00.

#### Section III: Duration.

Licenses issued under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be valid for a period of up to two (2) years. Licenses shall commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July or the date of issuance and shall expire on the thirtieth (30<sup>th</sup>) day of June of the second year. There is no proration of the \$20.00 fee for licenses shorter than the two-year term. To renew the operator's license, an applicant must submit a new application, signed and notarized, to the town clerk.

#### Section IV: Procedure.

- A. Each applicant shall complete the application form supplied by the town clerk.
- B. Applicants are subject to a criminal background check by a town-board designated law enforcement authority in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 125. The town clerk will contact the law enforcement authority to initiate the background check.
- C. At the next regularly scheduled town board meeting, the Clerk will present the application(s) and written results of the background check to the board. The board shall approve or deny the applicant's application after reviewing the findings of the background check. Upon town board approval, the town clerk shall issue the operator's license.

#### Section V: Display of Operator's License.

Each license issued under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be posted on the premises whenever the operator dispenses beverages.


Section VI: Revocation of Operator's License.

Violation of any of the terms or provisions of the State law or of this Ordinance relating to operator's licenses by any person holding such operator's license shall be cause for revocation of the license.
